

Cassie feels that volunteering has helped her greatly on a personal level improving her confidence, and in turn her outlook on life.








Celebrating Our Volunteers (continued....)

FUNDRAISING CRISIS

COVID19 lockdowns are having a devastating affect on our ability to raise funds for the vet care of our 160 plus VIB buns.

As we enter our second year of COVID-19, we have found ourselves continuing to struggle with raising funds for the ongoing vet care of the vib buns. Vet care costs is the largest expense that the orphanage faces, and as such we have gone online with a new **GoFundMe campaign**.

There is absolutely no help offered or available for rabbit rescue, and we are not eligible for grants offered to animal



rescues in the Government packages, as rabbits are not included under the Domestic Animal Act. We have exhausted our personal funds. Please help if you can as we cannot continue without funds.
